This special enrollment period (SEP), that runs through April 8, 2020 , will allow uninsured individuals 30 days to enroll in health insurance coverage through <i>Washington Healthplanfinder</i> . Until April 8, individuals seeking a special enrollment must contact the Customer Support Center between 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday-Friday at 1-855-923-4633; TTY: 1-855-627-9604, or a local certified broker or navigator, request the SEP, <i>and select a plan</i> by April 8 for coverage start date beginning April 1, 2020. Language assistance and disability accommodations are provided at no cost.
